



## JCCSF Adult Sports League Forfeit Policy

*Effective April 1, 2007*

- Any team that forfeits two (2) or more games in a given season will automatically be excluded from participation in that season's playoffs.
  - “*Courtesy Grace Forfeit Rule*”: When the JCCSF Staff Adult Athletic Coordinator is notified at least 24 hours prior to game time of an impending forfeit the forfeiting team will receive a “pass”. This means that the forfeit will not be counted towards the two game threshold. This grace rule can only be used once and only when 24 hour notice is given. Once notice of forfeit is given it is irrevocable.
  - All forfeits are recorded as a score of 0 – 50 (favoring the team that did not forfeit).
- Teams that forfeit two (2) or more times in one season will only be allowed one (1) forfeit before playoff expulsion in the next season they participate in.
- **Games will not be re-scheduled.** Teams are expected to have the minimal number of eligible players available at the scheduled game time.

### *Forfeit Rule*

**A team must have at least four (4) eligible players at game time to have an official game (i.e. avoid a forfeit).** The JCCSF will grant, at the discretion of the JCCSF Staff, up to a five (5) minute grace period for a team to meet the minimum number of players required to avoid a forfeit. Once the minimum number of team players is present the game must start. It is at the discretion of the team with the greater number of players to decide if they will play with four or five players.
