



## JCCSF Open Gym Policies

The Jewish Community Center of San Francisco is committed to creating a family-friendly atmosphere in all of our programming. This beautiful new facility affords us the opportunity to offer a multitude of program options to all of our members, including open hours in the gymnasium for basketball. The monthly open gym schedule indicates times that center members can be assured access to the gymnasium. This schedule is posted in the gymnasium, fitness center and is available at the front desk and on our web site ([www.jccsf.org](http://www.jccsf.org)).

We are here to serve the needs of *all our members* in a way that is consistent with the philosophy and values of the Center at large. We are also dedicated to keeping this new facility in top condition. With that in mind, we have established the following policies regarding our Open Gym hours.

- No food or drink (including sports drinks) is allowed in the gymnasium, except bottled water.
- Only non-marking soled shoes are permitted on the basketball court.
- The equipment in the gym, including baskets, curtain, and scoreboards, along with all closets, are to be operated by JCCSF STAFF ONLY.
- When the FULL Gymnasium is open the WEST court must remain open for half court games and children. The EAST court can be used for full court games.
- **Children** that are center members in the gymnasium:
  - Children age 12 and younger must be accompanied by a parent or caregiver while in the gymnasium at all times.
  - If the gymnasium is available, members can request at the JCCSF Front Desk or at the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Fitness Desk that one basket be lowered to 8 feet. For safety purposes we do not leave baskets lowered unattended.

IF PLAYERS ARE WAITING TO GET ON THE COURT, THE FOLLOWING POLICIES WILL BE IN EFFECT:

- Teams will be set up in the order that players arrive. You should sign in on the whiteboard located next to the fitness staircase to reserve your space in the next game.
- Games are to be played to 11, by ones
- Winning team stays on the court. However, no team may play more than 2 games in a row.

*Members are expected to participate in a respectful manner consistent with the core values of the Jewish Community Center of San Francisco. The use of inappropriate language, violence, or dirty play will not be tolerated. Members exhibiting any of these behaviors, or acting in any way deemed by JCCSF Staff to be contrary to the values of the JCCSF will be instructed to leave the gymnasium by the JCCSF Gym Staff immediately.*
